Grants will be reviewed in the month following submittal and grant leaders will be notified via email prior to month end if the grant was approved or not. The proposed project must be imaginative and innovative and not previously funded by local, state or federal taxes as MEF funds are not intended to replace public or ISD #332 revenues.

If you have previously received a Pony Express or Mustang grant from the MEF (not mini-grant), the written evaluation for the previous grant must be submitted before applying for another grant.
